# Producer Price Indexes

The producer price index is designed to measure the average changes in prices received in primary markets by domestic producers of commodities and services. The prices used for the index apply to the first stage of transaction. However prices at subsequent stage of transaction are used when it is impossible or inconvenient to collect such price data. Price data are generally collected in the sixteen major cities including Seoul. The index is calculated by a modified Laspeyres formula. The PPI index consists of 923 commodities and services.

# All Cities Consumer Price Indexes

※ The consumer price index(CPI) is designed to measure the changes in prices of commodities and services which are purchased by all consumer households in urban areas(36 cities), excluding farmer and fisherman households and one-person households. The base year is 2000(2000=100). The index items are 516 items. The weight of index items are derived from average expenditure of households for the base year 2000 obtained from the Family Income and Expenditure Survey. The price data are collected monthly for most goods and services, quarterly for school fees and three times a month for agricultural and marine products in 36 cities. The index is computed by the Laspeyres Formula.
